I would like to invite you to come and join Central Coast for Social Justice in a Circle of Silence in the lead up to the Federal Election. The Circle of Silence is an opportunity to let the community and our politicians know we want humane and compassionate refugee policies that reflect a government with a moral compass.

A Circle of Silence is about expressing solidarity with people seeking asylum and refugees experiencing injustice and who are being silenced. We stand in a circle in a public space for half an hour in silence, with signs telling people why we are there.

Every 5 minutes a bell will be rung and the names of the men who died on Manus will be read out. Information flyers will be distributed to people passing.
